

Publication Process and Guidelines

❖ Submit paper for publication: Make sure that the names of all authors and co-authors are registered and that all authors approve the submission.

Once Accepted

- 1. Forward the acceptance email with all the reviewers comments to the Research Assistant in charge of publications for 2018: addmar004@myuct.ac.za, mary@crg.ee.uct.ac.za
- 2. Various agencies invite applicants to apply for travelling allowances to partially support the presentation of the paper either internationally or in South Africa. The candidate is to explore these avenues before the paper is accepted.

Publication Process and Guidelines

- 3. It is the responsibility of the candidate to explore:
 - Student travel grants which are offered by the conference organizers. These opportunities will be advertised on the conference's website, or on the EDAS submission platform. https://edas.info/listAllTravelgrants.php
 - Conference Travel scholarships are available from the University of Cape Town Postgraduate Funding Office: http://www.uct.ac.za/apply/funding/postgraduate/awards/travel/

Deadlines for these applications

- ☐ The first round closing date is the 9 March for conference travel between April and September
- ☐ The second round is the 31 August for conference travel between October and March

Publication Process and Guidelines

- 4. If accepted papers fall within <u>well recognized prestigious conferences</u>, the Centre for Broadband Networks will partially provide financial support to the candidate presenting the paper.
- 5. Expenses spreadsheet needs to be prepared by the student and list maintained up to date for Mrs. Carol Koonin to process.
- 6. All expenditures must be authorized by the Head of the Centre for Broadband Networks.
- 7. Once the paper has been presented, all supporting materials including conference proceedings and supporting documents are property of the Department of Electrical Engineering or the Department of Computer Science and must be handed over to the Research Assistant in charge of publications
- 8. Upon return from the conference the author of the paper will give a 15 minute talk on his/her general impressions of the conference.
